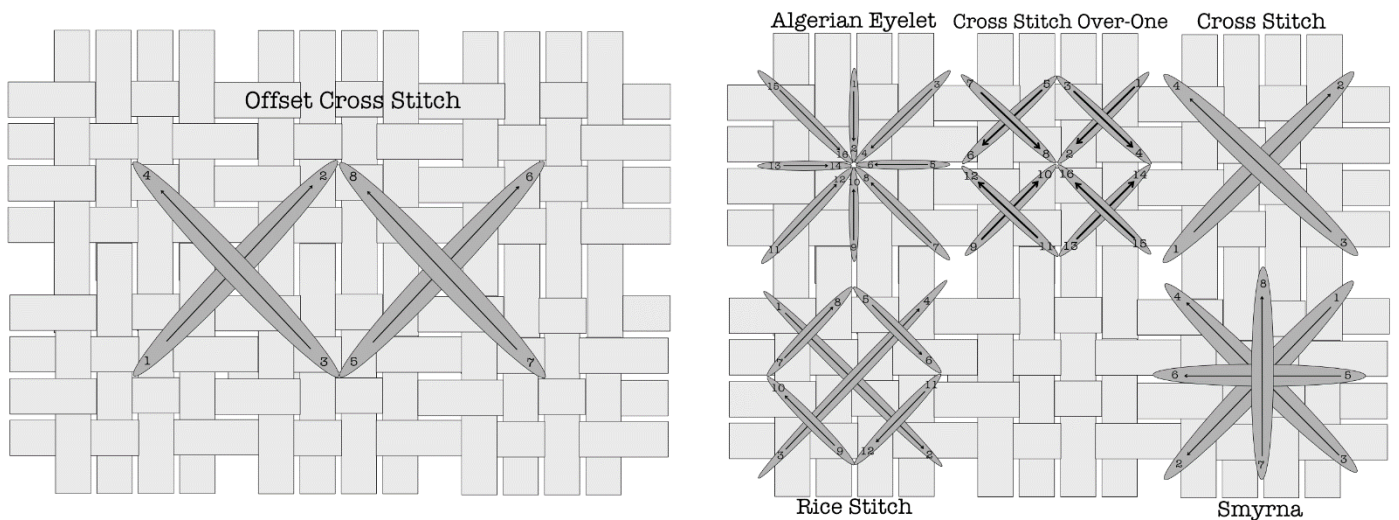
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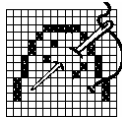


Specialty Stitches On Aida



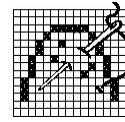
While it's rare to see a chart suggest Aida for a design with specialty stitches, some of them can be done on Aida. Offset Cross-Stitch means you will pierce the center of the block for all end points. It takes more effort to stitch any of these on Aida vs. on linen, as it means piercing the block that makes up how Aida is woven, but it can be done if you practice and are determined.

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Specialty Stitches On Aida

Aida is woven from 4 thinner ground fabric threads into a block. You can pierce the block by going between the block weave, but it does take some practice.
